The provided paper presents a study that aims to analyze the franchise agreement laws in Indonesia in relation to government regulations for technical assistance and the potential management of Indonesian franchise agreements. The study adopts a normative legal research design and examines franchise agreements and technology transfer within the intellectual property rights framework. Here are some suggestions for authors.

1. The paper should provide a clear overview of the background and context of franchising in Indonesia, highlighting its growth and the regulations governing franchise activities.
2. The paper raises two main issues for investigation: the consideration of international provisions on technology transfer in Indonesian franchise agreement laws and the formal recognition of franchise agreements as legal instruments for technology transfer. However, it also must introduce the importance of technology transfer and intellectual property rights within franchise agreements.
3. While the paper covers a range of topics, some sentences could benefit from greater clarity and precision. For example, the sentence "Franchising is the sole possession of a corporate structure with particular features that have been demonstrated to be effective and can be utilized by other entities under the terms of a licensing agreement by an individual or an organization unit" is somewhat convoluted and could be rephrased for better comprehension.
4. The paper does not explicitly mention any existing research or literature on topic, leaving it unclear how this study contributes to the existing body of knowledge. Including a brief statement on the research gap or the novelty of the study would enhance the paper's impact.
5. The paper briefly mentions the findings of the study, stating that Indonesian

franchise agreements do not comply with the Transfer of Technology Code (TOT-Code) and established franchise and agreement regulations. However, it does not provide further details or implications of these findings.
