

ABSTRACT

The title of this paper is “Metaphors Found in The Novel of *Remember Me*”. The data in this paper are taken from the novel entitled “*Remember Me*” by William Fettes. This paper is discussing about the types of metaphor found in the novel and also their literal and connotative meaning. The theories applied to support the paper are *Metaphor We Live By* written by Lakoff and Johnsen (2003).

Based on the result of the analysis, it is found that there are five types of metaphors found in novel “*Remember Me*”, they are dead metaphor, live metaphor, orientational metaphor, ontological metaphor, and structural metaphor. Furthermore, metaphors not only have a literal meaning but it also conveyed much wider meaning than that, which is connotative meaning. We have to pay attention a little deeper, in order to understand the meaning of it. When we only translate it literally, it may cause misinterpretation.
